As part of our co-curricular activities, we organised the Annual Sports Day, Fossick-Science Exhibition, and Discover –An Exploration for KG. These events provided platforms for students to showcase their potential in the chosen fields



Reinforcing the fact that talents have to be recognised and nurtured at a very young age, the school hosted UDBHAV-Interschool Competition for kindergarten in Drawing, Colouring, Clay moulding and Dancing. The participating little ones who were store-houses of talent just proved that the event was just a beginning for them to develop wings to fly!



Taking forward programmes directed towards character-building and life-skills, we organised the Annual Scouts & guides camp in the school premises. Students from different schools attended the camp for three days and got to experience various sessions on navigation, physical fitness, culinary skills, organising event, community living, saving resources etc. conducted by coaches and experts. It brought forth the motto of the movement, “BE PREPARED”.

As part of the school’s social responsibility, students participated in the NDTV BEHTAR India Campaign and contributed toward accumulating funds for creating a clean India, planting saplings in the school campus, cleaning of the areas around the school, spread awareness about hygiene and Dengue in the neighbouring Govt. Schools through street plays. Also, 38 students got together under the crowd funding platform, Fuel-A-Dream and collected Rs 8.37 lakhs to help senior citizen have cataract surgeries. The customary DAAN UTSAV witnessed our students donating items of grocery and home cleaning to the allied staff of the school. It is very heartening to see the younger generation respond to the needs of the community and contribute to the alleviation of disparities. There couldn’t be better ways to instil the value of empathy in students.



Students of the school have done outstandingly well in and outside of the school winning accolades for themselves. It is praiseworthy to note that Mrudul Ramakrishna has created a record by being the



only student from a new school to have qualified for the second level SMTE conducted by the DPS Society. He secured the 93rd inter-DPS rank for which he was awarded a cash prize and an opportunity to be part of a national academic camp in Science and Math organised in New Delhi. Many students of the kindergarten and primary classes have done extremely well in the MaaRS Spellbee competition and secured admirable positions at the national level. Pratyush Srivatsava of grade X has proved his proficiency in the language of English by securing the 1st International Rank in the International English Olympiad conducted by Science Olympiad Foundation.

We believe that a teacher who learns can also teach. It was with a sense of great pride and happiness that Ms. Elsa Robin was felicitated for being a CENTATPO2017 rank winning teacher. She secured a Subject national Rank of 16 in High School Biology. Her outstanding performance is a testimony of her excellent subject knowledge, pedagogy skills and practices. Every year all the staff members are encouraged to take up this annual teachers' Olympiad.
